**E**llen W. Elliott, age 68, of Rehoboth Beach, DE, formerly of Wilmington, DE, passed away on Friday, October 11, 2013, at the Delaware Hospice Center, Milford, DE. She was born on March 30, 1945, daughter of the late Howard L. and Sara E. (Short) White.

Ms. Elliott was born and raised in Rehoboth Beach. She was a 1963 graduate of Rehoboth High School and went on to manage her family's business, Rehoboth Products Company, before relocating to Wilmington, DE. In Wilmington she spent a 20 plus year career with AstraZeneca in the operations department. In 2006, Ms. Elliott would retire and move back home to Rehoboth Beach, but she remained very active.
