Violet G. Horn, "Cis", age 86, of Rehoboth Beach, DE, passed away peacefully on Thursday, September 12, 2013, at home with her loving family by her side. She was born on December 19, 1926 in Wilmington, DE, daughter of the late Charles and Hazel (King) Givens.

Mrs. Horn graduated from Conrad High School in Newport, DE in 1944 and went on to work for Hercules Inc., Wilmington, DE. Shortly after in 1946, she married her grade school sweetheart, Bayard R. 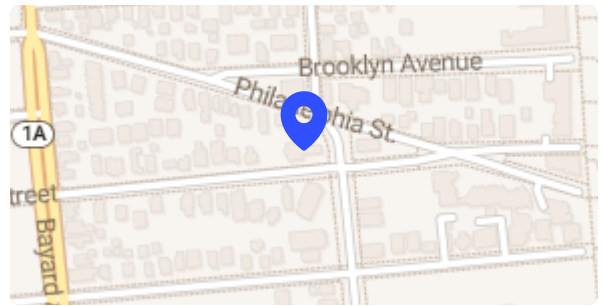
