**M**argaret F. Moore, age 94, a lifelong resident of Rehoboth Beach, DE passed away on Sunday, September 1, 2013 at her residence. She was born on June 28, 1919 in Lewes, DE, daughter of the late Joseph R. and Mary J. (Phillips) Moore. In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by four brothers: Lester S. Moore, Clifford A. Moore, Howard Moore and James Moore; three sisters: Mildred Phillips, Helen M. Joseph and Ida Moore; two nephews: James Moore, Sr. and Robert Moore and a niece: Irene Sobara.
