Sarah "Sadie" M. McPaul of Ocean View, DE, formerly of Magnolia, NJ, passed away on Sunday, September 01, 2013, at Beebe Medical Center, Lewes, DE. She was born Friday, December 29, 1922 in Port Glasgow, Scotland, daughter of the late Robert and Annie (Meikle) Russell. She was the wife of the late George M. McPaul who passed in 2002.
