Joseph G. Anastasi, age 69, of Rehoboth Beach, DE, passed away on Saturday, June 1, 2013, at Beebe Medical Center in Lewes, DE. He was born December 3, 1943 in Philadelphia, PA, son of the late John and Catherine (Mullen) Anastasi.

Mr. Anastasi enjoyed a lifelong career as a painter in Sussex County. He was affectionately known as a “jokester” by his many beloved friends around town and at the Rehoboth Beach VFW Post 7447. He enjoyed playing the slots at Dover Downs, and cheering the Philadelphia Eagles on anytime they were playing. He especially loved going to the State Park with his two black labs, Moe and Joe and his lifelong friend Carol.
