Naomi T. Gross, age 88, of Lewes, DE entered into eternal peace surrounded by her family on May 26th, 2013 at Renaissance Nursing Home in Millsboro, DE.

Naomi was born on December 26, 1924 in Port Deposit, MD, daughter of the late Harold and Esther Tyson. She graduated at the top of her class from The Tome School in Port Deposit, MD where she earned the honor of being named valedictorian of her senior class. She went on to earn a business degree from Goldey Beacon College in Wilmington, DE and was employed by the DuPont Company resigning after a few years to stay at home to raise her family. 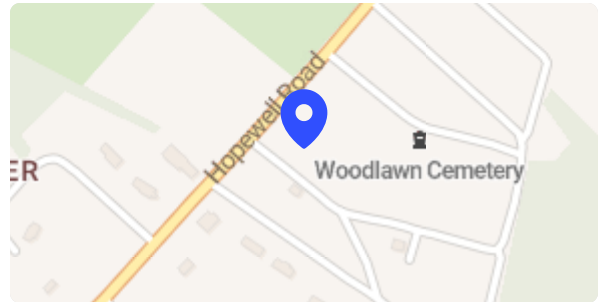
