**A**llan G. Tyson, Jr., age 85 of Rehoboth Beach, Delaware passed away on Sunday, April 7, 2013, at Harbor Healthcare & Rehab. Center in Lewes, Delaware. He was born March 12, 1928 in Chester, Pennsylvania, son of the late Alan G. Tyson, Sr. and Adelaide Birtwell Tyson.

Mr. Tyson was a 1950 graduate of Ursinus College in Collegeville, PA and received his law degree in 1953 from Temple University. He worked in private practice from 1955 to 1995 in the Chester and Swarthmore, Pennsylvania areas. He was a US Coast Guard Veteran.
