Mr. Thomas V. O'Hanlon, of Millsboro, DE passed away at his residence on Sunday, January 27, 2013 at the age of 76. He was born on May 12, 1936 in Philadelphia, PA, son of the late Thomas V. O'Hanlon, Sr. and Anne (Youse) O'Hanlon.

Mr. O'Hanlon dedicated 35 years of service to the Nabisco Company in Philadelphia, PA, retiring in 1991. Upon retirement, he and his family moved from Bensalem, PA to Millsboro, DE where he enjoyed the outdoors and spent many evenings watching the geese on the lake near his home.
