Ann Draper Tikiob, age 84, of Rehoboth Beach, DE said goodbye to her family after a valiant fight with heart disease. Mrs. Tikiob was born on July 30, 1928, daughter of the late Frank Warner Draper and Ruth Ann Willis Draper.
