Patricia Meade Thompson Burke “Patty”, age 67, of Lewes, DE, passed away peacefully at her home on Lewes Beach on Friday, October 5, 2012, with her loving family by her side. She was born on April 6, 1945 in Lewes, DE, daughter of the late Wesley Howard Thompson and Patricia Meade Layton.

Mrs. Burke spent most of her childhood growing up in Rehoboth Beach, DE. She attended the Mary Burnham School and the American School in Switzerland. Mrs. Burke enjoyed traveling extensively throughout Europe alongside her aunt, Anne L. Layton who served in various capacities with the American Foreign Service. She spent a lifelong career in Real Estate and was among the youngest of realtors to achieve the designation as a Real Estate Broker.

Mrs. Burke was never far from the beach and insisted before she would give her hand in marriage; her husband would have to move to the beach. She was truly a person with “sand between her toes”.
