**F**rank DelGaudio, Jr., age 68, of Milton, DE, passed away Sunday, September 23, 2012, at the Delaware Hospice Center, Milford, DE, with his loving family by his side. He was born on August 4, 1944 in Queens, N.Y, son of the late Frank DelGaudio, Sr. and Lucille Cuoco DelGaudio.

Mr. DelGaudio was a retired Suffolk County Police Officer on Long Island, NY. After retirement, he and his wife relocated to Delaware and he was finally able to live out a lifelong dream of becoming a General Contractor. He was a member of the Kings Creek Country Club, St. Edmond Catholic Church and a very loyal New York Yankee's fan.
