## **Jimmie D. Moore**

AUG 21, 1925 - SEP 10, 2012

**J**immie D. Moore , age 87, of Lewes, DE, passed away peacefully on Monday, September 10, 2012 at his residence. He was born in Philadelphia, PA, on Friday, August 21, 1925, son of the late Jimmie D. and Pearl (Buncasel) Moore. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Eugene Mascione and his step-father, William "Bud" Brown.

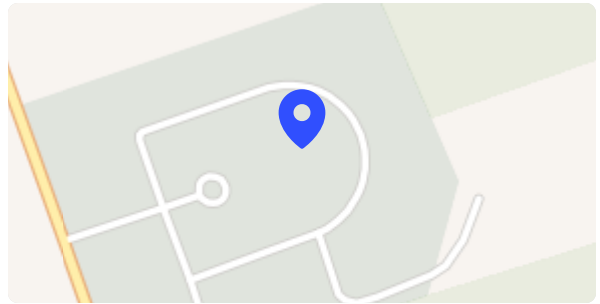
