Doris G. Warner, age 78, of Ocean View, DE, passed away peacefully on Monday, August 27, 2012 with her husband by her side. She was born on March 28, 1934 in Washington, DC, daughter of the late Donald and Margaret (Fields) Gardiner.

Mrs. Warner worked for the CIA in the early 1950s. She and her husband moved from Wheaton, MD to Ocean View in 1969; Mrs. Warner worked as a teaching aide at Lord Baltimore Elementary and Frankford Elementary schools for many years.
