Eddie was born June 4, 1936 and raised on a farm outside of Lewes. The Lord took him home on Thursday, July 12, 2012 at the Country Rest Home in Greenwood, DE.

He graduated from Lewes High School in 1954. He enjoyed playing basketball and played baseball in a town league and also played on The First Baptist Church team. He loved every part of his Masonry business. He also enjoyed his trucking business and his favorite hobby was working in his garden. At the age of 58 he became an avid golfer; he was a member of the Shawnee Country Club. He loved Misga and especially the ball tossers. Don McLamb, manager of the ball tossers, was a very special friend of Eddie's. His family, friends and golf buddies visited him regularly.

Eddie owned several timeshare weeks and enjoyed many trips with family and friends. Everywhere he travelled there was a golf course close by. He was a long-time member of The First Baptist Church in Lewes. He did quite a bit of the construction work on the different phases of the church building. He was a trustee, an usher, worked in the sound room and even sang in the choir years ago.

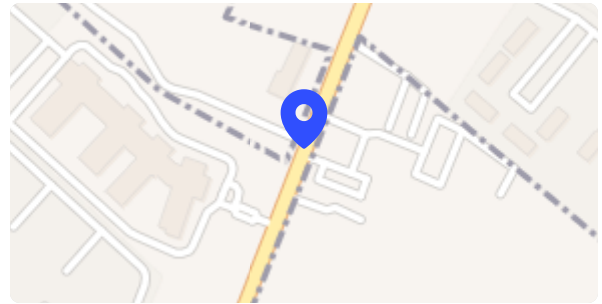

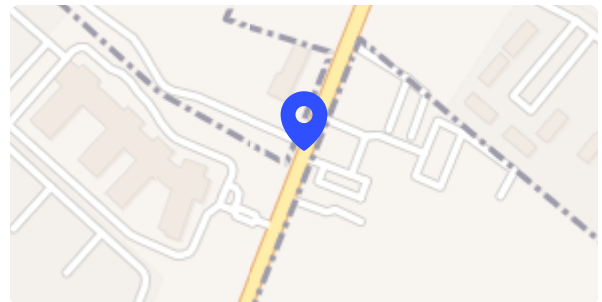
