Kelly Anne Carter age 91, of Lewes, DE, died on Tuesday, May 1, 2012 at Cadbury at Lewes.

Kelly Anne was born in Monroe, NC. She earned a B.A. degree from Salem College in Winston-Salem, NC. She was a Special Education teacher at the Charles W. Bush School in Wilmington, DE.
