Anthony D. Perrello , age 79, of Milton, DE, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, February 29, 2012, at Beebe Medical Center, Lewes, DE. He was born in the Bronx, NY, on Friday, January 20, 1933, son of the late Demetreo and Ida (Feno) Perrello.

A resident of Milton for the past 19 years, Mr. Perrello previously resided in Queens/ Flushing, NY where he retired from the Consolidated Edison Power Company as a Systems Analyst and Manager after 42 years. He was always involved with his church and was the Deacon and Treasurer of the First Baptist Church of Flushing, NY. He was also a past active member of the Kiwanis Club and Treasurer of their Foundation.

After moving to DE, he became a member of the New Covenant Presbyterian Church and earned the title "Elder Emeritus". He also lead a special bible study group every Monday in his community of Overbrook Shores. He was always interested in computers and formed a computer club in his community called "The Grumpy Old Men's Computer Club" and as a member of the Homeowners Association, he rewrote their bi-laws. 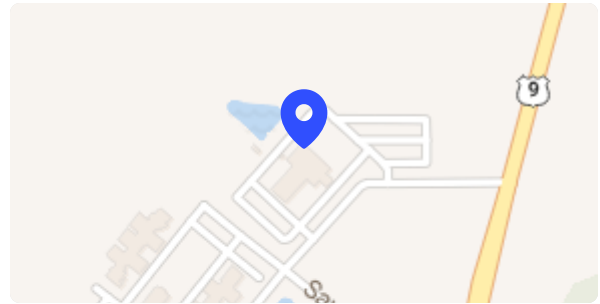

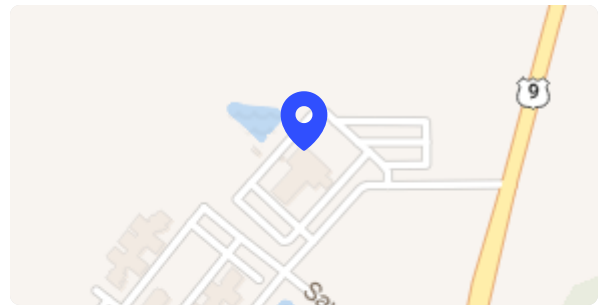

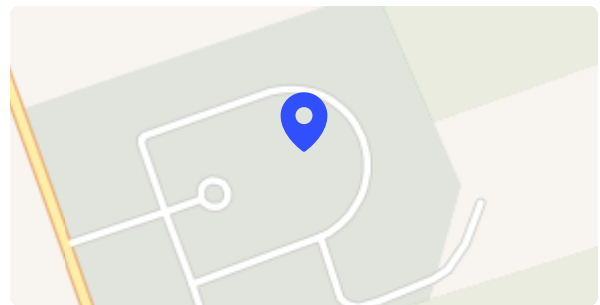
