After receiving his AA degree from the University of Delaware Mr. Wisniewski worked for New Castle County for 30 years in the maintenance division. 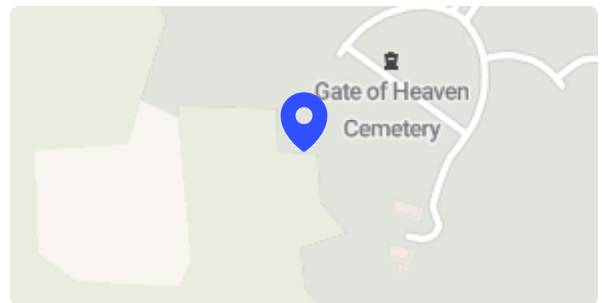
