Dorothy E. Reid, age 91, of Rehoboth Beach, DE, passed away peacefully on Friday, October 7, 2011, at Brandywine Assisted Living in Rehoboth Beach, DE, surrounded by her family. She was born in Philadelphia, PA, on February 2, 1920, daughter of the late William and Florence (Schulle) Ehinger.

Mrs. Reid graduated from Olney High School in Philadelphia. After graduation, she worked as a gifted seamstress in The Blum Store, a well known women's specialty store in Philadelphia. In later years she was a head teller with Central Penn National Bank, Southampton, PA branch. She was a faithful Army wife, homemaker and beloved Mother of two children. 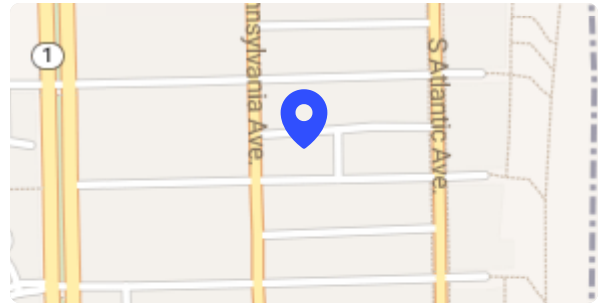

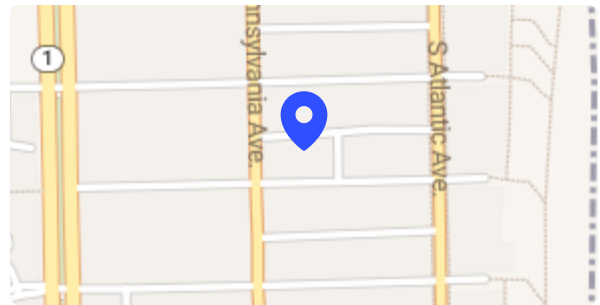
