JAN 26, 1924 - SEP 28, 2011

**V**iolet T. Richardson, age 87, of Georgetown, DE, passed away on Wednesday, September 28, 2011, at the Delaware Hospice Center in Milford, DE. Born on January 26, 1924, Violet was the daughter of the late Joseph and Ethel Thompson.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Ralph I. Richardson, Jr.; a sister, Beatrice Calhoun, and two brothers, Jennings "Dink" and Shep Thompson. She is survived by her children: Jo Dryden (Lit), Anne Forester (Joe), and Ralph "Buster" Richardson (Beverly); nine grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; two step-great-grandchildren; and a sister, Ann Bradley of Georgetown.

Violet retired in 1975 from the Selective Service System. She served as President of the following organizations: The Georgetown Home Demonstration Club, NARFE, and the Georgetown Historical Society. She served as Secretary of the Georgetown PTA. She was a member of Sussex Pines Country Club and St. Paul's Episcopal Church, serving as President of the ECW and Directress of the St. Agnes Altar Guild.
