Jason M. Ridley, age 32, of Rehoboth Beach, DE passed away on Tuesday, September 27, 2011, at Beebe Medical Center, in Lewes, DE surrounded by his family following a courageous two-month battle with cancer. He was born Monday, October 30, 1978 in Lewes, DE son of John D. and Lorraine M. (Dougan) Ridley.

Mr. Ridley graduated from Cape Henlopen High School, Lewes, in 1996. He then received his Beautician License from the Delmarva Beauty Academy in Salisbury, MD. Following school, he had a 15 year career working at his family's salon, John Lorraine European Hair, Rehoboth Beach. Mr. Ridley was a member of Lewes Church of Christ and was active in a personal Bible study group led by his close friend John Dadzie in which he enjoyed enhancing his faith. He enjoyed golfing, painting, skydiving, relaxing with friends, and most of all spending time with his wife Kelley, the love of his life. Mr. Ridley was a man of strong faith, humor, heart, and family; he will be sorely missed by all who knew him.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Ridley is survived by his loving wife of 18 months, Kelley (Daisey) Ridley; his soon to be born daughter; parents-in-law, Dean and Barbara Daisey of Millsboro, DE; sister-in-law, Kelsey Daisey of Millsboro, DE; grandparents, Barbara and Nole Ridley of England; and many aunts, uncles, cousins and dear friends.

A Celebration of Mr. Ridley's life will be held on Sunday, October 2, 2011, at 3:00 PM at Lewes Church of Christ at The Crossing, 15183 Coastal Highway, Milton, DE, where the family will receive friends beginning at 2:00 PM. Interment will be private.
