Charles “Barry” B. Chunn, age 66, of Lewes, DE, passed away suddenly on Saturday, August 13, 2011 at his residence. He was born October 5, 1944 in Montgomery County, MD, son of the late Charles Frederick and Alice Olene (Timmons) Chunn.

Mr. Chunn spent a career dedicated to perfecting the trade of custom carpentry and teaching it to others. He served with the United States Navy during the Vietnam war; is a member of American Legion Post 5 and the American Legion Riders Chapter 5, Post 5, both of Rehoboth Beach, DE. He loved surf fishing, the Redskins, and most of all his passion for riding motorcycles.
