William P. Dickerson Jr. age 81, of Lewes, DE, passed away on Friday, July 29, 2011 at Harbor Health Care, Lewes, DE. He was born in Lewes, DE, on December 19, 1929 son of the late William P. Dickerson, Sr. and Bessie C. Schmidt Dickerson. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife Doris Dickerson in 1998.

Mr. Dickerson retired from the US Air Force at the rank of Staff Sergeant where he had served as a Fire Protection Specialist throughout the Continental US, Europe, and Vietnam.
