Alfred Arthur Mousley, Jr. , age 86, of Lewes, DE, passed away on Monday, May 23, 2011, at his residence. He was born on May 26, 1924 in Wilmington, DE, son of the late Mary (Twaddell) and Alfred A. Mousley, Sr.

Mr. Mousley was a veteran of World War II. In 1956 he opened his own plumbing and HVAC company which he ran until his retirement. He served as past President of the Lions Club and of the plumbing and heating association. He enjoyed his farm and hunting with his sons and friends in Potter County, PA. He was a member of Groome United Methodist Church.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife Margaret (King) Mousley (2004).
