Carolyn T. Ramsey, 78, of Rehoboth Beach, DE, passed away on Friday, May 6, 2011, at Beebe Medical Center, Lewes, DE. She was born in Hazelton, PA, on November 8, 1932, daughter of the late William D. and Florence (Kraph) Trevorror.

Mrs. Ramsey graduated from Tamaqua High School, PA Class of 1950 and in 1953 she graduated from Methodist Episcopal Hospital School of Nursing, Philadelphia. Mrs. Ramsey was a Registered Nurse who worked in the Nursery at Kennedy Memorial Hospital, Stratford, NJ retiring in 1999. After retirement, she moved from Ocean City, NJ to Delaware.

She was a member of the Lutheran Church of Our Savior, Rehoboth Beach and she played the piano for the children's choir at United Methodist Church in Stratford, NJ.
