Robert Charles Moyer, Jr., age 56 of Bridgeville, Delaware passed away peacefully after a brief illness, surrounded by his family and friends on Monday, May 2, 2011, at Nanticoke Memorial Hospital in Seaford, Delaware.

He was born on December 5, 1954 in Washington, DC, son of Robert Charles Moyer, Sr. and Ethel Mae Fein Moyer.

Mr. Moyer was currently the owner and operator of Moyers Heating and Air Inc. Previously he had served as a policeman in Millsboro and as a correctional officer at the State Correctional Facility in Georgetown, DE. He was a member and current Vice President of the Bridgeville Volunteer Fire Department where he also served as a fire policeman and ambulance driver. He was a member and State Captain for the Patriot Guard Riders. Mr. Moyer was a veteran of the US Army and the US Coast Guard and was a member of the VFW of Greenwood and the American Legion in Seaford, DE.

He is survived by his wife of 33 years Bernadette Marie Moyer, sons Joseph Tallent of Bridgeville, DE, William Tunis of Hampstead, MD, George Tunis of Bridgeville, DE and John Tallent of Seaford, DE, daughters, Linda Tunis of Laurel, DE, and Karen Wright of Harrington, DE; his mother Ethel Mae Moyer of Milton, DE, a brother Brian Moyer of Milton, DE, and a sister Cynthia LeBlanc of Massachusettes; 11 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren.
