Mary Ann Rynkowski, of Rehoboth, DE, formerly of New Castle, DE, passed away on Sunday, April 24, 2011, surrounded by her family.

She was born to the late Richard and Mary Scully on April 9, 1926, in Wilmington, DE, where she grew up and graduated from Wilmington High School.
