Carl J. Hartz, Jr., 78, of Lewes, DE, passed away Saturday, April 23, 2011 at Beebe Medical Center, Lewes. He was born July 27, 1932 in Rochester, NY, son of the late Carl J. Hartz, Sr. and Margaret (May) Hartz.

Mr. Hartz enjoyed a long career with Delco Products of Rochester, NY and Consolidated Freight Ways of Henrietta, NY prior to relocating to the beach in 1988 from North Chili, NY. Mr. Hartz love of trailer camping and the ocean lured him to the Delaware beaches; he was a former Treasurer of the Indian River Yacht Club. He was a skilled woodworker who produced many cabinets and fine furniture. He was well known for his great sense of humor and his exemplary leadership. Mr. Hartz was a member of Mary Mother of Peace Catholic Church, Oak Orchard, and a 4th Degree Knight of Columbus where he was currently serving as financial officer. He proudly served as a U.S. Marine and was a past commander of American Legion Post #1830 Chili, NY.
