Mary P. Scott, age 93, of Bridgeville, DE, passed away peacefully on Monday, January 31, 2011 at Nanticoke Memorial Hospital, Seaford, DE. Mrs. Scott was born January 30, 1918 in Philadelphia, PA, daughter of the late John and Elizabeth (Milford) Price.

Mrs. Scott lived most of her life in the Philadelphia area where she was a member of the Hope Presbyterian Church. She worked as a receptionist for Dr. Karl F. Rugart. 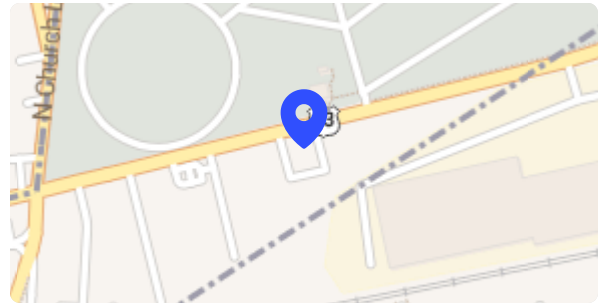
