Lucille B. Magee, age 95, of Lewes, DE passed away Sunday January 30, 2011 at Harbor Healthcare & Rehabilitation Center, Lewes. She was born December 13, 1915 in Wilmington, DE, daughter of the late Stanley and Sophia (Bartosheska) Zegler.

A lifelong resident of Delaware, Mrs. Magee resided in Wilmington, South Bethany and Georgetown prior to moving to Harbor Healthcare. She was a member of St. Jude The Apostle Catholic Church and a member emeritus of the Junior Board of Christiana Hospital.
