Mary Duggan Schappert, age 82, of Rehoboth Beach, DE, died peacefully on Tuesday, January 25, 2011, at the home of her daughter surrounded by her loving family. She had a long battle with Alzheimer's Disease . Mary was born July 5, 1928 in Flushing, Queens, NY, daughter of the late William and Katherine (Rowland) Duggan.

Mary lived most of her life in Babylon Village, NY. She was a dedicated and loving daughter, mother, wife and grandmother.
