Charlotte Lankford Wootten, 83, of Galestown, MD passed away on Thursday, January 20, 2011, at Peninsula Regional Medical Center in Salisbury.

She was born on August 24, 1927, daughter of the late Atley A. and Mabel W. Lankford.

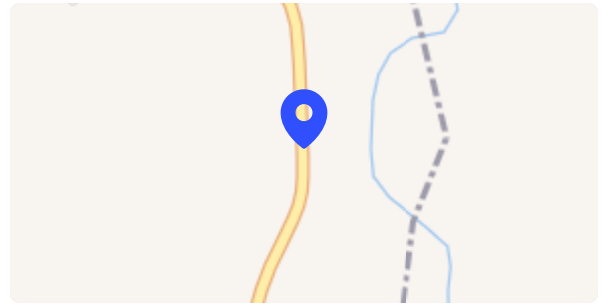
