**A**nn Marie Perogine, age 66 of Lewes, DE, passed away after a long battle with cancer on Tuesday, January 18, 2011, at her residence. She was born on Saturday, August 19, 1944 daughter of the late Henry Ross and Ann (Lukaszewicz) Kozicki.

Born and raised in Wilmington, DE, she spent much of her childhood as a dancer and graduated from Wilmington High School in 1962. She worked as a secretary for the DuPont Company and as a graphic artist for Farley Printing Company.

Ann Marie's greatest passion was being a mother and grandmother. She was always able to provide great comfort to those around her. She enjoyed cooking, pampering her pets and relaxing on the beach or on her boat.
