Joseph "Jay" F. Egan, Jr, age 50, of Lewes, DE, passed away suddenly on Tuesday, January 12, 2011 at his residence. Born on January 30, 1960 in Schenectady, NY, he was the son of the late Joseph F. Sr. and Eileen (Houlihan) Egan.

Jay was a resident of Delaware for the past 20 years, where he worked in various restaurants in Rehoboth Beach and Lewes. Jay loved the beach, enjoyed snow skiing and loved his family, especially his two daughters, Cate and Keeley Egan.
