**D**avid F. Coe, Jr. age 77 of Dagsboro, DE, formerly of Pennsylvania, passed away on Dec. 27, 2010. Mr. Coe retired from Westinghouse Electric Corp., in Lester, PA where he had been employed in the Electrical Dept. for 33 years until its closing in 1986. Prior to that time he had served in the United States Airforce from 1951-1955 as an aircraft mechanic, stationed in Anchorage, Alaska. He was an accomplished musician and played drums in clubs throughout Delaware and Philadelphia Counties until moving to Lower Delaware in 2008

He is survived by his wife, Shirley M. (Thomas) Coe, and two children, David Mark Coe of Turnersville, New Jersey and Susan Beth Ciociola-Coe of Dagsboro, DE, two grandchildren Scott David Ciociola and Samantha Lynn Ciociola and a brother, Wayne Otis Coe of Claymont, DE.
