Agnes "Christine" (Simonsen) Henning age 96 of Lewes, DE, passed away peacefully on Sunday, December 19, 2010, at her residence. She was born in Clay County, NE on Tuesday, April 14, 1914, daughter of the late John V. and Carrie (Hansen) Simonsen.
