Rex Morehouse Enos, age 80, of Ocean View, DE died at his home on October 21, 2010. Rex was born in San Francisco, California on January 28, 1930. He served in the Air Force during the Korean War. He received his B.S. degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of California at Berkley in 1957. Rex retired from Melpar/E-Systems after 37 years. Rex is survived by his wife of 51 years, Patricia Enos, his five children, Mark Enos, Brian Enos, Paul Enos, Michele Hodapp and Ann Tietz, and five grandchildren.
