Joseph "Joe" Adolfo Ferrer of Lewes, DE passed away peacefully on April 13, 2010 at Beebe Medical Center, Lewes, DE. He was born in West Chester, PA on February 1, 1939, son of the late Joseph Adolfo Ferrer, Sr. and Edith Bender Ferrer.

Mr. Ferrer graduated from Henderson High School, West Chester, PA in 1956 and continued on to Penn State University where he obtained a BS in Business Administration and a brotherhood in Alpha Tau Omega fraternity.
