**W**anda A. Tomlinson, 68, of Georgetown DE, formerly of Cape May, NJ, passed away on Friday, January 8, 2010, at Beebe Medical Center in Lewes, DE. Born Monday, August 18, 1941 in Ludlow, VT, she was the daughter of the late Maurice and Dorothy (Nashville) Metivier.

Wanda was the first female bus driver for the New Jersey Transit Authority in the South Jersey Area and was a member of their 25 year club. She retired in 2000. She was a member of Grace United Methodist Church, a member of their choir and Glee Club and Pocahontas Lodge of Delaware. She traveled the country camping in 45 states and enjoyed gardening and reading.

She is survived by her husband of 50 years, Robert E. Tomlinson of Georgetown; one son, Robert E. 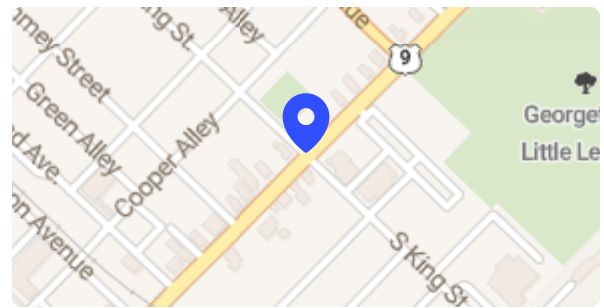

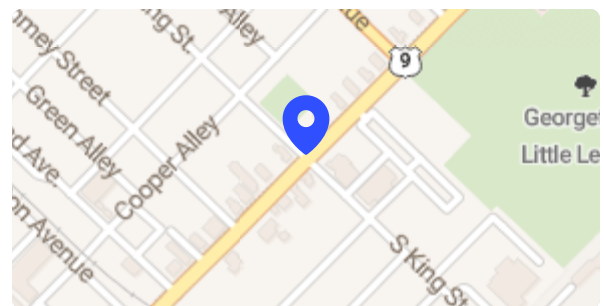
