John “Jack” A. Salin of Whiting, NJ, formerly of Rehoboth Beach, DE, passed away on Wednesday, November 4, 2009, at his residence with his family by his side. He was born August 14, 1913 in Washington, DC, son of the late Charles S. and Florence (King) Salin.

Mr. Salin graduated from the University of Delaware with a degree in electrical engineering. He was a IEEE Life Senior Member and a reserve officer with the U.S. Navy who was called to duty during World War II.
