Roy Eugene Lowery, 65, of Seaford, DE, died Sunday, October 18, 2009 at his home under Heartland Hospice Care after a long battle with lung cancer.

Born on May 26, 1944 in Pennsylvania, he was the son of the late John Henry Lowery and Rita Martha (Jordon) (Lowery) Sipple. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by one sister, Shirley Ann Dively.
