Jacob H. Faust, age 78, of Rehoboth Beach, DE, died peacefully at his residence on Saturday, October 3, 2009. Jake was born and raised in Philadelphia, PA, son of the late Jacob David and Lydia (Schroeder) Faust.

Mr. Faust attended Dobbins High School and went on to receive an Electrical Engineering degree from Drexel University. He worked 34 years in the engineering department of Unisys Corporation in Malvern, PA before retiring to Rehoboth Beach in 1992. He was a man with a great sense of humor who enjoyed life and always took on the challenge of repairing anything that was broken. He had an avid love of fishing and boating. Jake was an active member of the Lutheran Church of Our Savior, currently serving as an Elder and Eucharistic Assistant. He was instrumental in developing the Shepherd's Program at the church.
