**E**dward Eugene Clark, Sr., age 90, of Lewes, DE, passed away at his home on Thursday, June 18, 2009. . He was born September 8, 1918 in Louisville, KY, son of the late Isodore and Sarah (Langley) Clark.

Mr. Clark enjoyed a long career of 30 years with the Hecht Company in Washington, DC from which he retired in the late 1970's as a Jr. Executive.
