George W. McDonald, age 74, of Rehoboth Beach, DE, formerly of Arnold, MD, went home to be with the Lord suddenly on Wednesday, April 8, 2009. He was born December 29, 1934 in Chicago, IL, son of the late George and Marge (Rachton) McDonald.

Mr. McDonald was the owner of McDonald Masonry in the Annapolis, MD area from which he retired in 1994. He was also a masonry instructor at South River Vocational-Technical School and was a salesman for Surgical Specialties in Annapolis, MD. He served in the U.S. Marine Corps during the Korean War.
