Rudolph "Rudy" A. Zeleny, Sr., age 78, of Lewes, DE, passed away peacefully at his residence on Sunday, October 15, 2006, surrounded by his loved ones. Mr. Zeleny was born May 3, 1928 in New York City, NY, son of the late Anton J. and Rose A. (Adamac) Zeleny.
