Donovan Scott Appleman of Lewes, DE, died April 14 after a prolonged illness at Pennsylvania Hospital, Philadelphia, PA. He was 37.

Donovan was born and raised in Altoona, PA. While residing in PA, he was employed at Corning Glass. He moved to DE in 1999, working for the Rehoboth Police Dept. and for Trinity Trucking. He settled in Lewes, DE, working as a waiter at a number of local establishments.
