**M**ary Ann Parker Vincent, age 83, of Bridgeville, DE, died Saturday, April 15, 2006 at her late place of residence. She was born March 14, 1923 in Bridgeville, daughter of the late Luther and Blanche (Truitt) Rust.

In her early years of employment, Mrs. Vincent had worked at the Sussex Guide, a publication company, as a dark room technician. She also worked as a waitress at the Seaford Golf and Country Club, the former Harley's Restaurant in Seaford, and the Seaford Inn. During World War II, she had worked at a munitions plant. She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church, and over the years, attended Concord United Methodist Church in Seaford as well as Union United Methodist Church in Bridgeville. She was a former member of the Eastern Star, Seaford, and was a member of the Nanticoke Senior Center and the Red Hat Society. Most importantly, she was a devoted Mother, Grandmother, and Great-Grandmother who will be missed by all.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Carl T. Vincent in 1980, a step-son, Robert Vincent in 2004, and by two brothers, Carlton and Ralph both formerly of Bridgeville.
