## Morris Henry Schultz, "Ice Cream Consumer"

Morris Henry Schultz, age 79, of Greenwood, DE, formerly of Severn, MD, passed away on Monday, July 13, 2015 at Harrison Senior Living, Georgetown, DE. He was born in Severn, MD on October 8, 1935, son of the late Morris F. and Elizabeth M. (Crause) Schultz.

Mr. Schultz proudly served in the U.S. Air Force from 1954 to 1958. After his honorable discharge, Mr. Schultz made a career in the retail food industry. First with Acme Grocery chain in Annapolis, MD and then 30+ years of dedicated service with Giant Foods, working in various locations across Anne Arundel County in Maryland. Mr. Schultz would embark on a second career, owning and operating the Shore Kleen Chimney Sweep in Denton, MD. Although he was a tireless worker, Mr. Schultz would retire in 1997, relocating to the Seaford, DE area, passing on his chimney sweep business to his son.
