Geraldine "Dolly" Carodiskey, age 80, of Lewes, DE passed away on Thursday, July 9, 2015, at the Delaware Hospice Center in Milford, DE. She was born Thursday, March 28, 1935 in Shamokin, PA, daughter of the late Joseph and Marie (Mohorovic) Luksic.
