Stanley "Stan" L. Thompson, age 87, of Rehoboth Beach, DE passed away on Monday, June 15, 2015. He was the son of the late St. Clair and Lou Emma Thompson, born July 4, 1927 and raised on the family farm in Farmington, DE.

Stan attended Farmington Grade School, Greenwood High School and graduated from the University of Delaware "49" with a degree in Agriculture Business. He became owner of Nassau Feed and Grain and Edgehill Drugs in the mid 1950's promoting each company's growth for many years to come. He was a local business leader active in real estate development, banking, aviation and a past Beebe Hospital Board Member. In later years, he became a constant gardener, walking enthusiast and an avid reader but most of all he loved spending time with his family. Stan's family will miss him dearly!

Stan will always be remembered for his vision, work ethic, sense of humor and the honest and fair manner he related to all people during his life.
