**W**illiam "Bill" H. Gremminger of Lewes, DE passed away peacefully after a courageous battle with leukemia on Wednesday, May 27, 2015. He was a son of the late John E. and Sara (Barraclough) Gremminger.

Mr. Gremminger was a 1953 graduate of St. James High School in Chester, PA. He continued his education at Villanova University and graduated from Spring Garden College in 1960. In 1961, Bill married Catherine Cehyra, to whom he was fully devoted for the next 53 years.

Mr. Gremminger was employed by the DuPont Company for 32 years, retiring in 1992. He enjoyed playing baseball for many years and in retirement spent many enjoyable hours on the golf course. He was especially fond of time spent in The Villages, FL. Bill always took great pride in his family and enjoyed meeting the challenges of repairing or improving whatever enhanced his home.
